

Dear Parents,

As you know, we have over 1000 students here at LMS. For several years we have been housing some of these students in the modular classrooms called the “mods” by many. This year we will have a seventh grade team, an eighth grade team, and two E.S.L classrooms in the units.

We have 10 classrooms contained in these modular units. Two classrooms are connected with a common door inside of each of the five units. All outside doors remain locked throughout the day. Each classroom has its own temperature control, has been cleaned and refurbished with new carpeting and new exterior doors have been installed.

The teams contained in the modular units will have all four of their core classes within the units. Students will enter the building for CATS classes, some ESL classes, and lunch. The bathrooms and lockers are also located inside the building for our students in the modular classrooms. There is a security guard stationed at the back door throughout the day to help in the smooth transitions of students in and out of the building.

Safety drills are held for the modular units as any other classroom in the building. During severe weather drills, we will practice moving the students into the main building. Students are encouraged to wear sweaters or jackets during chilly weather for the outdoor transitions.
