	<p style="text-align: center;">446. WORKERS' COMPENSATION</p> <p>1. Purpose Professional employes shall be entitled to the benefits of workers' compensation in the event of injuries occurring while at work, but shall receive no other compensation in regard to work-related injuries. Employes shall be entitled to use accumulated sick leave for work-related injuries; however, workers' compensation shall be deducted from sick leave payments.</p> <p>2. Procedure Professional employes who are injured during the performance of their duties shall make a written report of the accident. The report shall be made on forms provided by the District and shall be filed within twelve (12) hours of the accident. In the event it is impossible for the employe to file the accident report personally, it shall be the responsibility of the employe's immediate supervisor to complete and file the report.</p> <p>In order to become eligible for insurance coverage for medical treatment, the employe must select from one of the licensed physicians or practitioners of healing arts designated by the District. The employe must follow procedures established by the provider of the District workers' compensation program.
