

SCHOOL BOARD MINUTES

- (1) The Board of School Directors of the Lebanon School District met as a committee-of-the-whole on Monday, September 11, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. in the board conference room of the senior high school as advertised in the Daily News on December 6, 2016.
- (2) President Peter N. Pyles, Jr. called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
