124. Summer School

Purpose

As funding permits, the District will provide for a fully accredited summer school program for resident students of the district, either as a district-operated program or in cooperation with neighboring school district.¹

Summer school course offerings shall, whenever practical, include supplemental and/or remedial courses on all grade levels. All courses will comply with the standards of the State Board of Education and the rules and regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Education.

In order to support a program of summer instruction, the Board shall:

1. Employ teaching and administrative staff.
2. Provide necessary books, materials, supplies, and equipment.
3. Utilize schools or other facilities as required.
4. Provide necessary custodial services.

Planned instruction offered in summer school may be designed as credit or noncredit offerings.

Guidelines

All courses shall be taught by certified teachers. Admission to classes is open to students and adults under specific conditions.²

Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for:

1. Planning the summer school curriculum.
2. Recommending appropriate staff appointments.

3. Evaluating and reporting on student progress.
4. Utilizing facilities.
5. Developing and enforcing rules for student behavior.

Guidelines for the operation of summer school shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of summer school shall not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions.
