124.1 Summer Programs

Authority

It is the policy of the Board that the district offers summer programs to provide academic and enrichment opportunities for resident students of this district. ^{1, 2, 3}

In order to support a summer program of academic and enrichment opportunities, the Board shall:

1. Employ teaching and administrative staff.
2. Provide necessary books, materials, supplies, and equipment.
3. Utilize schools or other facilities as required. ⁴
4. Provide necessary custodial services.

Academic opportunities will be planned and provided to meet the needs of students who are in danger of retention and/or struggling in reading and mathematics. Student selection for summer programming will be prioritized based on need. ⁵

Guidelines

Enrichment opportunities will be planned and provided as an incentive for students who are attending summer programs for academics. Enrichment opportunities may also be provided for students who are meeting or exceeding academic expectations.

Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for:

1. Planning the summer school curriculum.
2. Recommending appropriate staff appointments.
3. Evaluating and reporting on student progress.
4. Utilizing facilities.
5. Developing and enforcing rules for student behavior.

Guidelines for the operation of summer programs shall be consistent with Board policies, and the operation of summer programs shall not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions.
