205. POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS

It shall be the policy of the Board of School Directors to assume no responsibility for making its regular educational program available to residents of this district who are high school graduates or who have attained the age of twenty-one (21) years, nor shall the Board be responsible for such continuing education for such residents in the schools of any other district, or in public or private institutions.¹

The Board of School Directors will consider the extension of the privilege of postgraduate study in the regular educational program to high school graduates residing in this district upon proper application and the satisfaction of the following condition(s):²

1. The specific objective of the candidate is dependent upon the completion of certain courses offered at the high school.
2. The past scholastic and behavioral conduct of the candidate is such as to predict success in the selected postgraduate courses.
3. The needs of undergraduate students regularly enrolled in the school are met and classroom space and instructional staff are available.

The Board may approve, on the recommendation of the Superintendent or his/her designee, each qualified application for postgraduate studies before the student may begin such studies. Such approval shall not be construed to extend beyond the academic year for which application is made.

The continued attendance of each admitted postgraduate student shall be contingent upon the maintenance of a satisfactory academic performance, regular attendance, and a record of good conduct.
