## **231. SOCIAL EVENTS AND CLASS TRIPS**

### **Purpose**

The Board recognizes the value of student social events and class trips in enhancing and enriching the school experience for students.

### **Authority**

The Board will make school facilities available for social events that have been approved by the building principal. The building principal is responsible for providing appropriate staff for supervision.<sup>1</sup>

Any social events and/or class trip activities which take place outside of the district and/or require that the students stay at a location overnight require the approval of the Superintendent prior to the event or trip occurring.

### **Guidelines**

As voluntary participants in school social events and class trips, students shall be held responsible for compliance with rules set forth in advance for their conduct, as well as the Code of Student Discipline. Infractions of those rules will be subject to the same disciplinary measures as are applied during the regular school program.<sup>2</sup>

Participation in school events is not a right and may be denied to any student who has demonstrated disregard for the policies and rules of the district or the school.

## **Delegation of Responsibility**

The Superintendent or designee shall develop procedures for the conduct of student social events and class trips which include the following:<sup>3</sup>

1. Designation of a staff member who shall be the school employee responsible for the event;
2. Provision of adequate adult supervision at all times, or police protection as required by the circumstances of the event; and
3. Formulation of rules and regulations governing the conduct and safety of all participants and the distribution of such rules and regulations to all students and adults involved.
