## **240. COLLEGE COURSES**

### **Purpose**

This policy provides high school students with an opportunity to take college courses while they are enrolled in the District.

### **Delegation of Responsibility**

The Superintendent or designee shall develop procedures to implement a Dual Enrollment Program for high school students.

The Superintendent or designee will provide Dual Enrollment Program information to students and parents/guardians.

### **Guidelines**

Procedures for the implementation of a Dual Enrollment Program shall include the following:

1. List of local colleges participating in the Program.
2. Eligibility requirements.
3. Application procedures.
4. Restrictions on course load.
5. Approval process.

Before the District approves study at the college level for any student, all options for advanced study within the subject area presently provided by the District should be explored.

With the exception of a District approved Full Day Program, no more than one (1) course per semester at the college level will be paid for by the District, for any one (1) student.

Decisions related to coursework for students with Gifted Individualized Education Programs (GIEP) will be made by the student's GIEP team in accordance with applicable law and administered through the District's Dual Enrollment Program.
