

School-Family Compact

Provisions

School Responsibilities

The Lebanon Middle School will:

1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating students meet the standards.
2. Hold parent-teacher conferences two times a year, during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the child's achievement.
 - a. October 5 and 6
 - b. January 25 and 26
3. Provide families with frequent reports on their children's progress.
 - a. 6 interims
 - b. 6 report cards
 - c. Parent Portal access to Power School.
4. Provide Families reasonable access to staff. Staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:
 - a. Emails are provided on the Lebanon Middle School Web page.
 - b. Parent conferences are scheduled.
 - c. Open house will be held September 13.
 - d. Phone messages are given to teachers daily.
5. Provide family members opportunities to volunteer and participate in the school.
 - a. Family Connection Group – on Facebook and monthly meetings held.
 - b. Volunteer opportunities provided for family members to sign up at open house and by announcement.
6. Individually assist students that are struggling

- a. Academic Support Plans
- b. Behavior Plans
7. Self-monitoring grades on PowerSchool/Schoology
 - a. Requesting assistance when needed.
 - b. Keeping parents informed about progress.
8. Read and follow the Code of Conduct
 - a. Take document home for your parents.
 - b. Consult planners when needed.

Family Responsibilities

We as family members, will support our children's learning in the following ways:

1. Monitoring attendance.
2. Making sure that homework is completed.
3. Volunteering in the school.
4. Participating, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my children's education.
5. Promoting positive use of my child's extracurricular time.
6. Staying informed about my child's education and communicating with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school or the school district (available on the website), received by my child or by mail, and responding as appropriate.
7. Reading the monthly newsletter (available online or by request).
8. Serving, to the extent possible, in parent groups or advisory committees.
9. By returning the annual parent survey.
10. By participating in the creation of the school improvement plan when the opportunity arises.
11. Monitor student grades and progress by the use of PowerSchool.
12. Keep contact information up to date.
13. Read, review with your child, and Sign the Code of Conduct.

Student Responsibilities
